




Flagship Impact Shakers Accelerator

The Impact Shakers Accelerator is a 9 month accelerator for underrepresented founders in Europe to scale their impact startup.

It is where we work directly with exceptional founder teams and connect them to our own impact investment vehicles as well as to our partner impact investment ecosystem. Our scaling method is based on our startup paradigm and built upon the 3 pillars of embedding impact, partnering for systemic change and wellbeing & care.

Portfolio



Vested Impact is a data platform that provides ESG assessments to asset managers based on the UN Sustainable Development goals (positive or negative), leveraging automated, trusted and independent data.



Sila Health connects people in Africa to quality healthcare using a chatbot (Sis Joyce), in person consultations with health care specialists and a payment function for friends & family.



Sensegrass is a smart farming solution that combines soil intelligence with precision farming. SenseGrass offers 360 farming solutions based on cutting edge technology like Nano-Satellite Mapping, Rover Bots and Al-based mobile & web application that make farming more efficient & precise.



Compocity is an automated composting robot that converts office food waste into value. It offers community building through gamified sustainability challenges with data monitoring. The compost will be certified as organic fertiliser and distributed to local farmers, making it an end-to-end solution.



VYLD develops and produces innovative period products (starting with tampons) from seaweed proving user-centric product-excellence, radical sustainability and empowerment can go hand in hand. Their products not only empower womxn and reframe the social stigma associated with periods, but they are also trailblazers for a circular economy in accordance with nature -leveraging the incredible potential of algae.




The Joy Club is the go-to online community for retirees, where peers with shared interests can enjoy online events, content and conversation (online & offline).




Our Impact

Small negative impact due to data processing & server emissions of the tech-heavy portfolio >> working to develop reduction / offsetting strategy with the portfolio.




